

Security of attachment of press fasteners on children's clothing DIN CEN/TS 17394-3

Purpose

"DIN CEN/TS 17394-3" specifies a procedure for testing the security of attachment of press fasteners on children's clothing



The test is suitable for

- Clothing textiles for children up to 14 years
- Hats, caps
- · Scarves, shawls
- Gloves
- · Stockings, socks
- · Textile belts
- Ties

The test is not applicable for

- Articles for childcare (diapers, bibs)
- Footwear (slippers, shoes, boots)
- Toys (including carnival costumes)

Description

The test procedure described in DIN CEN TS 17394-3 is intended for the following components:

Metal press fasteners including snap-fit fasteners

The standard also mentions minimum requirements that must be met in order to reduce the risk of such components of being detached in use by children.

Requirements for test samples

General:

The tests are carried out on ready-made garments.

Quantity of material needed:

A sufficient number of representative test pieces of each type, size and combination of components and fabric should be provided to carry out five individual tests.

Duration of testing:

After a maximum of 10 working days, you will receive a detailed test report with descriptions of the test samples and the test results.
