


The Green Button is a state seal for sustainably produced textiles. It sets binding requirements to protect people and the environment in the production process of textiles. What is special about the Green Button is that, in addition to the product, the company as a whole is always inspected.

As a certification body approved by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), Hohenstein is authorized to test companies and products for compliance with the criteria for awarding the Green Button textile seal.

- OEKO-TEX® MADE IN GREEN for the areas of fibre and material use, wet processes, ready-made garments/products
- OEKO-TEX® STANDARD 100
  for the area of fibre and material use
